GTCD Budget and Membership Update (R. Knop and A. Chase)

- Current financials distributed in Board packet
 - April passed out simple budget (YTD as of August 31, 2018)
 - AOR and Arthouse invoices have been paid. Operating account is at approximately \$90K.
 - April is having conversation with CNDC to sort out income categories (in kind, donations, sponsorships, etc.)
- Current membership
 - \$4K in renewals September
 - Approximately \$25K still out in renewals

GTCD Fundraiser (A. Chase/S. Ilg)

- Budget is good. Have received \$6,666 in ticket sales
- Received a \$5K sponsorship from Councilman New's office, towards goal of \$10K
- 140 tickets sold to date (goal is 200)
- Sharing event on social media/emails this week & next
- Food and alcohol all set
- Call for all Board members to purchase tickets and get two others to purchase as well
- Sydney has event posters, can drop off for posting at businesses and cultural and residential buildings
- Volunteer sign up list coming through SignUpGenius.com
- Sydney needs guest names for cultural partner employees who have purchased 2 for 1 tickets
- Check in system in place, should take 1 minute or less
- Donations: Have 35+ items for auction

Executive Committee updates

- Homelessness in GT working on speakers for Nov. 1 Board meeting
- Election Season Board queries
 - Kristy had a conversation with CNDC regarding GTCD support of candidates and issues. GTCD can decide to support or not support an issue, but cannot state a position on candidates.
 - Comments and questions:
 - Candidates and those representing policy & initiatives can attend Board meetings.
 - Should the Board be proactive about issues or wait for organizers to approach Board?
 - RiNo Board is inviting both sides of the "Right to Survive" initiative to an upcoming Board meeting.
 - Suggestion that the Board wait until closer to the May 2019 election to decide on what issues to hear.
- Committee procedures document review with Board. The goal is to feed into GTCD general strategy plan. Asking for feedback from Board – copy Kristy, Jennifer & Rhonda.

- Banners update: Jackie designed branded banners to go on poles along Acoma. Putting together a team to get these up before the fundraising event. City is helping with installation of larger banners.

Golden Triangle Improvements – S. Ilg

- Submitted request for \$100K to City Council for crosswalk art project
- Working on application for "P.S. You are Here" grant for another crosswalk art project at 14th near the Denver Art Museum
 - Competition for this grant varies year to year, 12-20 projects usually funded. Application due Oct 17. Recipients are announced within 1 month, then funds distributed are in 2019. Can apply for to up to \$10K. Have to anticipate a source for matching funds. Letter of commitment from business support is helpful.
 - April will run application by CNDC.
- Met with Bike Denver regarding alignment on Broadway bike lanes
- Next meeting is Oct 17, 4 pm DAM Admin Building

- Gart property new decision to sell property for \$25M, includes Sports Castle & additional properties
- Evans School rumor of tear down. New owners have no plan to tear down.
- GTCD will co-host an October Final Fridays event on Oct 26 with the Center for Colorado Women's History at the Byers-Evans House. Two house tours offered, 15 people per tour. Cost is \$5 and includes a spooky reading and refreshments following the tour. CCWH will set up the Eventbrite site for ticket sales.
- Civic Center Conservancy celebrates its 100 year anniversary of the theater and memorial in 2019. \$4M in bonds set aside for Greek theater programming. Events will be held on 6 Friday nights, 5 Saturday nights in 2019 to reactivate the space (including partnerships).
- Conservancy will offer second Fridays events (food, plus beer & wine), fourth Saturdays (create and consume culture). Will be reaching out to community for ideas.
- There a many measures on the November ballot that effect business owner lodging sales taxes. Keep in mind what taxes add up to. Travel and tourism will be effected.
